BALLOT ISSUE 2A PASSED!



Thank you for approving ballot issue 2A to create a funding source for our roads!

With the support of Eaton residents, the Town now has a dedicated funding source for transportation projects. The Town will begin collecting a 1% Sales and Use Tax as a dedicated street fund. The tax is estimated to

produce \$1,575,000 annually and will be collected starting January 2024. This tax will be used to maintain, construct, and restore streets, sidewalks, and related infrastructure such as curbs and gutters, storm drainage, ADA accessibility, roadway widening, and safety improvements.

NEW GRANT FUNDING FOR TOWN PROJECTS!

The Town is excited to announce that we have received two grant awards from the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) totaling over \$2 million! These grants will go toward our downtown streetscape construction outlined in our Downtown Revitalization Plan. It reimagines our downtown along two blocks of 1st Street by replacing the road, widening

sidewalks, adding streetlights and landscaping, a parking lot extension, and an outdoor seating plaza. A second grant will go toward placing over 300 water meters within our Town, improving our water efficiency. Find more information about what these grants will cover on our website at eatonco.org.
