# **UTILITY RATE INCREASE**



In 2023, the Town conducted a rate study to evaluate whether it collected enough revenue to cover water, irrigation, and wastewater operations, maintenance, capital reinvestment costs, and replacement projects. The study, conducted by a third-party consulting firm, revealed that the current rates were not covering all necessary operational costs. The Town will be raising utility rates effective April 1, 2024. The rate increase also includes a new tiered system for residential rates.

Residential customers can expect the base water rate to increase from \$49.12 to \$58.09, and base sewer rates will increase from \$29.15 to \$33.48 per month. More information can be found on the Town's website. Customers will receive their first bill with the new rates at the beginning of May as the Town bills in arrears.


